TUITION AND FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students applying to enroll are required to pay a non-refundable application fee. Students who require an I-20 will be charged a refundable fee to process the visa.

I-20 students are charged the international student tuition rate and are required to pay the year in advance. All tuition and fees must be paid at the issuance of the I-20 and prior to enrolling in classes. No additional discounts are given. Tuition is non-refundable.

TUITION

The yearly tuition cost represents the total cost of educating each student in the respective grades for the entire year. The tuition includes fees such as labs, music, student association, honor societies, and graduation. Students will be given one PE uniform per year and one music uniform during high school, at no cost.

BILLING PROCEDURES

Students with unpaid accounts will not be permitted to take semester exams, receive grades or transcripts and may not participate in school-sponsored activities and/or trips.

Students graduating from Kindergarten, 8th and 12th grades may not participatin graduation services or receive a diploma or final grades unless the account is paid in full.

REQUIREMENTS

- The student must demonstrate a proficiency of English by a personal interview and/or TOEFL test score of 80.
- An international student must have a guardian in the United States mainland. The name, address and the telephone number must be sent in with the application.
- An official copy of transcripts and school credits for all grades from 9th grade and onward
 must be sent in a sealed envelope. If the transcript is not in English, it must be translated into
 English before submitting.
- A current immunization record including infant records and also a TB skin test result must be sent to the school. A physical exam must be completed by a physician and sent to the school.
- Personal reference forms should be completed and returned to the school.
- Must provide proof of health insurance coverage.
- Each student must complete a foreign student application as well as the RAA application.
