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TUITION AND FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students applying to enroll are required to pay a non-refundable application fee.

I-20 students are charged the international student tuition rate and are required to pay the year in advance. All tuition and fees must be paid prior to the issuance of the I-20. No additional discounts are given. Tuition is non-refundable.

TUITION

The yearly tuition cost represents the total cost of educating each student in the respective grades for the entire year. The tuition includes fees such as labs, music, student association, honor societies, and graduation. Students will be given one PE uniform per year and one music uniform during high school at no cost.

ADDITIONAL CHARGES

Tuition cost does not include health insurance, 7-12 textbooks, field trips, and lunches. Students with unpaid accounts will not be permitted to take semester exams or receive grades and may not participate in school-sponsored activities and/or trips. Students graduating from Kindergarten, 8th, and 12th grades may not participate in graduation services or receive a diploma or final grades unless the account is paid in full.

FIELD TRIPS

REQUIREMENTS

In applying for admission to RAA, the international student must comply with the following :

- The applicant must complete the online application forms and submit them to the administration office along with translated transcripts (AERC is the recommended corporation - www.aerc-eval.com a detailed report is required), immunization records from birth, physical and TB, and a recommendation form from his/her current school teacher, school counselor, or school principal
- A TOEFL Internet Based Test (TOEFL iBT) or iTEP Academic Test is required.
- In compliance with California state laws, medical and immunization information and TB test results must be completed and returned before the student can be considered for acceptance.
- A non-refundable application fee of \$350 (U.S.) is required before a conditional letter of acceptance is issued. The application process to receive the final acceptance and I-20 must be completed by June. This letter of conditional acceptance will expire on June 30.
- Student acceptance will be based on his/her grades, TOEFL or iTEP score and/or Skype interview, and recommendation forms.
- When the transcripts have been received and full tuition has been paid, the I-20 form and an acceptance letter will be issued to the student.
