Tuition Rates

Tuition does not cover the full cost of operating Redlands Adventist Academy. Members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church support Adventist education with substantial church and conference subsidies. Therefore, students and/or families who are members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church are charged the SDA subsidized rate.

The tuition rate for grades TK-8 combines the cost of most educational field trips that are part of our curriculum, miscellaneous fees, and classroom supplies.

Tuition for grades 9-12 does not include miscellaneous fees and school related trips. Please refer to a list of additional charges for all grades in this brochure.

Billing Procedures

The annual tuition amount is the cost of attending RAA for a school year. For your convenience, the annual tuition charge is divided into 11 installments and billed July through May. The monthly installment plan is designed to divide the cost over 11 months and does not signify the cost per month to attend RAA. A monthly statement will be emailed to the financially responsible party. Monthly payments are due and payable at the 1st of each month.

No refund will be given for extended absences or vacation periods.

Early Withdrawal

When a student prematurely withdraws from school, a parent or responsible party must fill out a withdrawal form with the office. A student who withdraws during the school year will have the annual tuition prorated. This may result in a credit or a balance on the account, depending on the date of withdrawal.

Mid-Year Enrollment

A student who enrolls after the beginning of the school year will have the tuition prorated with additional charges added based on grade level and the date of enrollment.

Tuition Assistance

Redlands Adventist Academy does not want finances to be an obstacle that prevents a student from receiving a Christian education at RAA. There are sources of tuition aid available which are outlined in the Financial Aid & Scholarship Program brochure. The enrollment and aid assessment applications online must be completed to be considered for financial assistance. You maximize your access to financial assistance by applying early.

Registration

All outstanding accounts at RAA or other SDA schools must be cleared prior to registration at RAA.

All students must apply or en-enroll online through FACTS. Registration is not complete until the tuition payment due has been paid.

New students are required to pay a \$150 non-refundable deposit to register. This deposit will be applied as a credit to the account once the enrollment is completed. There is no deposit required for returning students who have registered through FACTS by March 31, 2019. After this date, returning students will be required to pay the \$25 FACTS re-enrollment application fee and the \$150 non-refundable deposit.

Financial Clearance

Tuition and fees charged to a family account must be paid in full each month to receive financial clearance for overnight trips, semester and final exams, and participation in graduation services for grades K, 8, and 12. Cash or money orders may be required for payment on delinquent accounts.

All accounts must be paid in full by Zero Balance Day on May 14, 2020.

Delinquent Accounts

Accounts must be kept current. Students whose accounts are more than 30 days past due will be placed on an attendance hold until the amount is paid in full or satisfactory financial arrangements are made. Students with unpaid accounts will not be permitted to take semester exams and participate in school-sponsored activities and/or trips. No refunds will be granted for any days missed due to delinquency-related withdrawal.

Discounts

Prompt Payment

A prompt payment discount of \$5 per student will be given if the account balance is paid in full by the 10th of each month. When the 10th falls on a Saturday or Sunday, the discount will be given if the payment is received by the next business day. Payments are considered late after the 20th of each month.

Annual Tuition

There is a \$150 discount per student if tuition is paid in full by July 31, 2019. Families receiving the annual tuition discount are not eligible for the prompt payment discount.

Fourth Child

For families with 4 students, a family discount of \$1,600 per year divided over 11 months is given to the 4th student.

Before/After School Care

Before and after school care is available from 6:30 a.m - 7:30 a.m. & 3:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m. Monday - Thursday and 12:30 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. on Friday at the rate of \$4.50 per hour. There is a late charge of \$10 per 5 minutes after closing. Charges are included in the statement and are due and payable on the first of the month.

School Lunch Program

Lunch is available Monday - Thursday. Meals may be purchased for \$5 via FACTS. Friday lunches are provided by fundraising entities and are not part of the school lunch program.

International Students

Students on an I-20 visa are required to pay a \$350 non-refundable application fee. These students are charged the international tuition rate which must be paid in advance, prior to the issuance of the I-20 visa.

Payment Methods

Families are encouraged to pay online using FACTS ParentsWeb. You may also pay with check or cash at the business office. Two-party and post-dated checks are not accepted. Credit/Debit cards are accepted for donations only.

Textbooks

Elementary

The cost of elementary textbooks and workbooks are included in tuition.

Junior High and High School

Students in grades 7-12 are required to purchase their own textbook materials from a vendor of their choice. Required online textbooks and resources are usually purchased by the school and will be charged to student accounts at the beginning of the school year. Please see the 7-12 textbook list for up-to-date information.

Fundraising Credits

The scrip program and other school sponsored fundraisers designated for the benefit of the students are an easy and effective way to earn money. Credits earned will be posted in a separate account in FACTS and may be used for field trips or tuition per email request to finance@redlandsacademy.org. Credits earned are not refundable.
